The **MLEADEREDIT** command is used to add a leader to a multileader object or remove a leader from a multileader object.

## Command Access:

**Ribbon** : Annotation > Leader > MLEADEREDIT

**Menu** : Modify > Object > Multileader > Add

**Command** : MLEADEREDIT

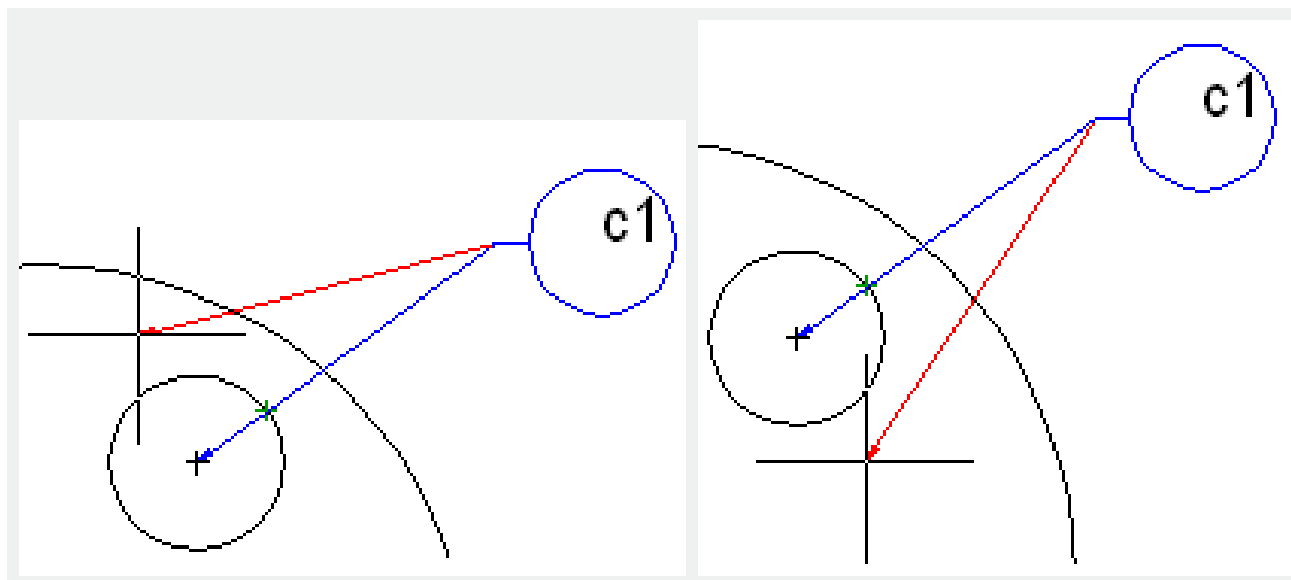
## Command Prompts:

Specify leader arrowhead location or [Remove leaders]:

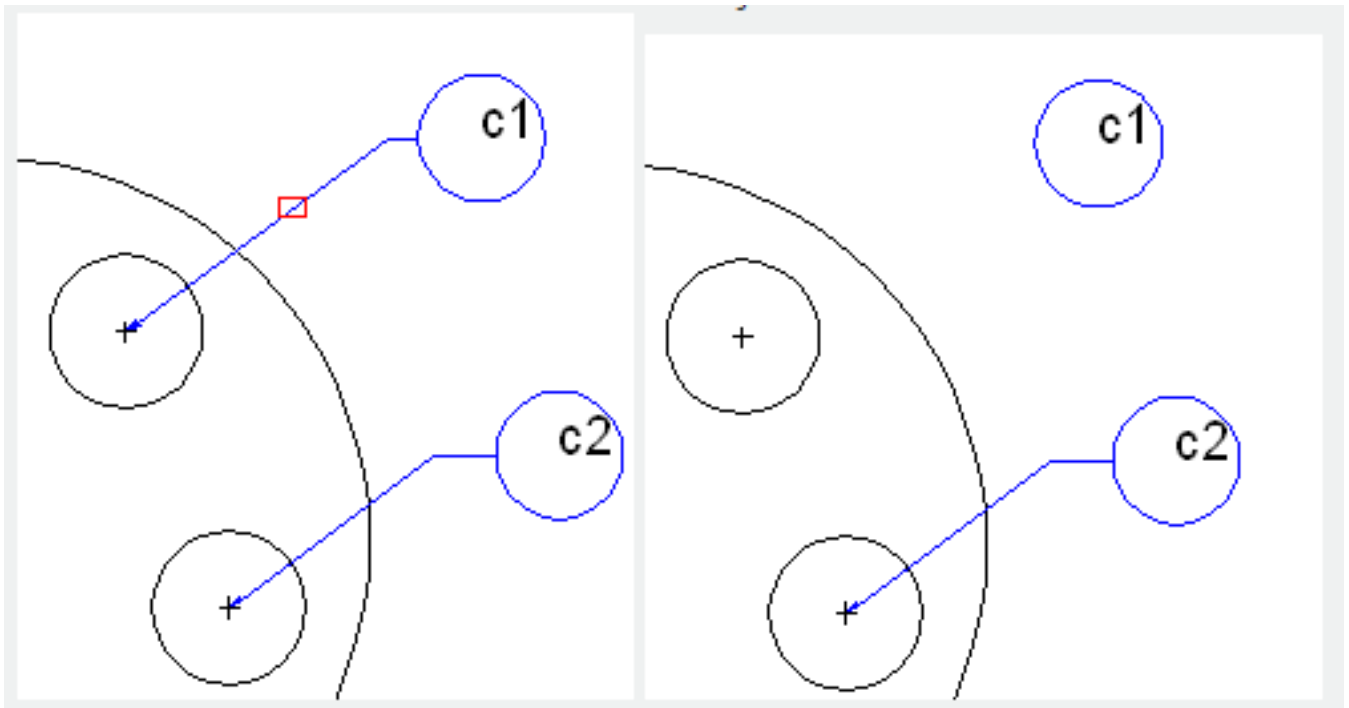
## Relative Glossary:

### Add leader:

Add a leader to a selected multileader object. The new leader will be added on the right or left of multileader according to cursor.



**Remove leader:** Remove leaders from selected multileader object.
