The **MTEXT** command is used to create a multi-line text.

## Command Access:

**Menu** : Text > Multiline Text...

**Command** : MTEXT

## Command Prompts:

Current text style: "Standard" Text height: 2.5 Annotative: No

Specify first corner point:

Specify opposite corner or [Height/Justification/Linespacing/Rotating/Style/Width/Column]:

## Function Description:

Users could change several text paragraphs to a single multi-line text and use "Text Formatting" to edit the text appearance, column, and boundary.

Inputting "-mtext" under command prompt, it will display other prompts without "Text Formatting" dialog box.
