You can use object properties or object types to include or exclude objects in or from a selection set.

If you want to filter selection sets by property (like color) and by object type, you can use Quick Select (<u>QSELECT</u>) from the Properties palette (<u>PROPERTIES</u>) or the Object Selection Filters dialog box

(FILTER). You can name and save filters for future use with object selection filters.

If you want to filter your selection set based on <u>COLOR</u>, <u>LINETYPE</u> or lineweight (<u>LWEIGHT</u>), first consider whether these properties are set BYLAYER for any objects. If a circle's color is set to BYLAYER and the layer color is red, it can not be select by filter based on red color.
